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Dear Referee, Thank you for your Comment in the interactive discussion on our manuscript entitled Acoustic Doppler Current Profiler observations in the southern Caspian Sea: shelf currents and flow field off Freidoonkenar Bay, Iran. In fact these results are a part of an extensive field study in the southern part of the Caspian Sea, which covered eastern and western coastal waters. Beside the ADCP records that are presented in this manuscript, two moorings containing six RCM9 (Recording current meters) were deployed for almost eight months in western and eastern parts of Iranian

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waters in the Caspian Sea down to 200 meter depth. Some paper concerning the later moorings results are under preparation and most probably will be submitted at current journal. I am certain that results will be more interesting.
